We encourage you as a family to research some of the Catholic history of Mardi Gras and pick a way to truly celebrate this festival before Lent.

“Begotten”

The EDGE night on this week your child will learn about one of the most prominent and hardest part of the Creed to understand—Jesus is “begotten not made” and “consubstantial with the Father”. They will learn that Jesus has a unique relationship with God the Father as His only begotten Son and that Jesus is consubstantial with the Father, meaning that they are of the same nature and essence. Essentially this reveals the pivotal marker of our Faith that Jesus was born fully man and fully God. Here are some questions to ask your son or daughter this week:

- 1) **What part of the Creed did you learn about at EDGE? What does it mean?**
- 2) **What would our faith be like if Jesus were only God or only man?**
- 3) **How does this teaching affect our daily life and the way we live our faith?**
- 4) **What was your favorite part about the EDGE night?**

**Parents, I comment you for your continued dedication and support of your child’s faith journey. This time in middle school can be a time of great change in our youth. It is important that we look at our Faith over and over so that it grows up and matures with our children. “God only gives us what we are ready for”

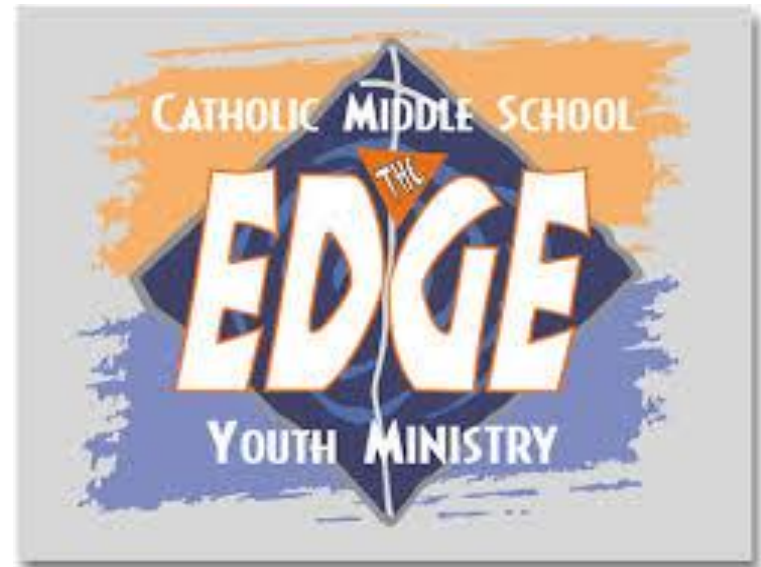
